Ocean Institute's 40th Annual Maritime Festival: A Celebration of History, Community, and Ocean Education

The **Mermaid Breakfast** offers a more serene start to the day, where guests can enjoy a whimsical meal in the company of enchanting mermaids, creating memories that will last a lifetime. Indulge in a whimsical **Afternoon Mermaid Tea**, where guests can sip on specialty teas and

enjoy delightful treats with enchanting mermaids in a setting that brings oceanic fantasy to life.

Adding to the excitement, the festival will feature **free Pirate Adventure Shows**, a series of dynamic performances that you can enjoy from the shore. These shows will bring pirate legends to life with sword fights, daring escapades, and plenty of swashbuckling fun, all set against the picturesque backdrop of Dana Point Harbor.

But the fun doesn't stop there. Visitors can unwind in the **Beer Garden**, where live music from local bands will set the perfect tone for a day by the sea. Families will find plenty to explore at **Sailor's Camp** and **Lil' Lads Landing**, areas specially designed for younger festival-goers. Sailor's Camp will offer hands-on activities that immerse children in the life of a sailor, while Lil' Lads Landing will be filled with carnival games, crafts, and educational booths that provide both fun and learning opportunities.

Stroll through **Peddler's Village**, where artisan vendors will showcase their unique merchandise and food trucks will offer a variety of delicious bites to satisfy every craving. For those seeking a more relaxed experience, the **Salty Seadogs Saloon** offers a waterfront lounge and bar with specialty cocktails. Here, you can marvel at the majestic tall ships, enjoy the ocean breeze, and watch the pirate shows unfold right before your eyes.

The crown jewel of the weekend is **The 3rd Annual Pirate and Mermaid Ball**, a magical evening under the stars that invites guests to don their finest pirate or mermaid attire. This exclusive event combines gourmet dining, live music, and dancing, creating an unforgettable night where fantasy and reality blend seamlessly. Not only will attendees revel in the enchanting atmosphere, but they'll also be supporting a noble cause, as proceeds from the ball contribute to Ocean Institute's educational programs, ensuring that the magic of the ocean is passed on to future generations.

To make your festival experience as smooth as possible, we've arranged for free parking and free shuttle service to help you avoid the traffic and hassle. On Saturday, you can park at **Marco Forster Middle School**, and on Sunday, parking is available at **Dana Hills High School**. Shuttles will pick up every 25-30 minutes from 6:30 am to 8:15 pm, making it easy to get to and from the event.

For Friday events, there is limited parking available at Baby Beach South Lot, but please note there will be no festival parking or shuttles on Friday. We highly encourage ridesharing or utilizing the Dana Point Trolley to make your visit more convenient and stressfree.
